Thoughts to take Home

Often it is said that the opposite of "Faith" is "Logic or Reason". This is not true.

The opposite of "Faith" is "Unbelief".
The opposite of "Logic or Reason" is "The Illogical" or "The Irrational".

Thus, our faith in God should be a "Logical" or "Reasonable" faith.

So, how do you know if your Faith is rational or irrational?

If we were standing next to Moses when his people were trapped next to the Sea, and we saw him raise his staff over the water, what would our honest thoughts be about Moses mental state at the time?

In hindsight we recognize Moses' faith as rational, why? Because he had good evidence that God would act to save His people.

Thus, how does our trust in God remain logical even when God might ask us to do something illogical?

How would we know that this "illogical" request was really from God?
